



Description

Gabled roof stecak at the site of Koposici near Ilijas, central Bosnia. It is richly decorated with motives of borders, spirals, grapes, rosettes and triangles on the roof sides of monument signaling that it represents eternal home. Local tradition connects this stecak with Vukava – wife of Great Bosnian Prince Batic Mirkovic who is buried next to this monument. Beginning of XV century.

Data were collected as part of a joint research project between GDH and the Association for the Digitization and Informatisation of Cultural Heritage (DIGI.BA) in Sarajevo. Description provided by Dr. Edin Bujak, Archaeologist, Univerzitet u Sarajevu.
