Bacchus statue from the site of Tarraco (Tarragona, Spain), dated in the 2nd century AD. Marble statue of Bacchus, god of wine, inspired by Praxiteles' pouring satyr. It would have been part of the sculptural decoration of a domus in the residential area of Tarraco.
