



## Description

Petroglyph with one or two anthropomorphic figures heavily pecked into the stone, and a four-legged figure, perhaps an ibex, lightly scratched on the rock at a different time. Still under study.

Al Mudaifi is an archaeological site on a small hill on the north end of the town of Khor Fakkan on the east coast of Sharjah, UAE. It consists of a large number of petroglyphs that span the periods from the Neolithic to the 19th century. GDH ID 8
