



Description

Cerro de las Cabezas is an Iberian Iron Age site located 8 km south of the current city of Valdepeñas, in the province of Ciudad Real, Spain. It was inhabited from the 6th century to the 2nd BC.

The data for this project were collected in 2017 as a joint effort between the University of Castilla-La Mancha (UCLM), the Fondazione Bruno Kessler (FBK), Baraka Arqueólogos SL and CVASt at the University of South Florida (USF) under the legal permission of Junta de Comunidades de Castilla-La Mancha (Expte. 16.0834-P1. Sistema de documentación 3D del Patrimonio Cultural de Castilla-La Mancha). The project is now managed by UCLM and Global Digital Heritage (GDH). UCLM project co-Director Dr. Víctor Manuel López-Menchero Bendicho provided the data for this model.
